CODE OF CONDUCT For Participants

We are fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all our members. The club believes it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents/guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Tony Ford or a member of the management team.

As a member of Hinckley Gymnastics Club you are expected to abide by the following club rules:

- All members must participate within the rules and respect coaches, judges and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents and fellow club members.
- Apply themselves to learning
- Behave in a non-violent manner
- Refrain from any form of discrimination, harassment, bullying or intimidation
- Resolve conflict in a peaceful manner
- Refrain from carrying any type of prohibitive material such as illegal drugs or weapons
- Play an active role in the shaping of the Clubs' daily life
